

**ENSLEY TOWNSHIP  
NEWAYGO COUNTY, MICHIGAN  
(Ordinance No. 09-4)**

At a regular meeting of the Township Board for Ensley Township held at the Township Hall on April 7, 2009, beginning at 8:00 p.m., Township Board Member Starr made a motion to adopt this ordinance/ordinance amendment, which motion was seconded by Township Board Member Folkema.

**AN ORDINANCE/ORDINANCE AMENDMENT TO AMEND  
SECTIONS 7 AND 8 OF THE ENSLEY TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL  
PENALTY, CIVIL INFRACTION, AND APPEARANCE TICKETS  
ORDINANCE (ORDINANCE NO. 03-1).**

**THE TOWNSHIP OF ENSLEY (the “Township”) ORDAINS:**

Section I. This ordinance/ordinance amendment pertains to Ensley Township Ordinance No. 03-1 which is commonly known as the “Ensley Township Municipal Penalty, Civil Infraction, and Appearance Tickets Ordinance.”

Section II. Section 7 of the Ensley Township Municipal Penalty, Civil Infraction, and Appearance Tickets Ordinance (Ordinance No. 03-1) is hereby amended to read in full as follows:

“Section 7. Authorized Persons-Civil Infraction Tickets. Unless prohibited by state law or unless otherwise provided by specific provisions of a particular Ensley Township ordinance to the contrary, the following individuals are hereby designated as the authorized Township officials to issue and serve municipal civil infraction citations for violations of Township ordinances which provide for a municipal civil infraction for a violation thereof:

The Newaygo County Sheriff and all other Deputy County Sheriffs of said  
County  
The Township Zoning Administrator  
The Township Ordinance Enforcement Officer  
The Township Supervisor  
The Township Clerk  
The Township Building or Code Official  
Any State Police Officer”

Section III. Section 8 of the Ensley Township Municipal Penalty, Civil Infraction, and Appearance Tickets Ordinance (Ordinance No. 03-1) is hereby amended to read in full as follows:

“Section 8. Authorized Persons-Misdemeanor Appearance Tickets. Unless prohibited by state law or unless otherwise provided by specific provisions of a particular Ensley Township ordinance to the contrary, the following individuals are empowered to issue and serve Appearance Tickets for violations of Township ordinances which contain criminal misdemeanor penalties for violations of the ordinance involved:

The Newaygo County Sheriff and all other Deputy County Sheriffs of said County  
The Township Zoning Administrator  
The Township Ordinance Enforcement Officer  
The Township Supervisor  
The Township Clerk  
The Township Building or Code Official  
Any State Police Officer”

Section IV. Except as expressly amended by this ordinance/ordinance amendment, the balance of the Ensley Township Municipal Penalty, Civil Infraction, and Appearance Tickets Ordinance (Ordinance No. 03-1) shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

Section V. Severability. The various parts, sections, and clauses of this ordinance/ordinance amendment are hereby declared to be severable. If any part, sentence, paragraph, section, or clause is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this ordinance/ordinance amendment shall not be affected thereby and shall remain in full force and effect.

Section VI. Effective Date. This ordinance/ordinance amendment shall become effective thirty (30) days after its publication (or publication of a summary thereof) in a newspaper of general circulation within Ensley Township.
